Kabir's neighborhood has so many different sights, sounds, and smells.



HELP KABIR MAKE IT HOME


Kabir is hurrying home with freshly made kadooboo for his Amma. And yikes, it looks like rain!



MESSAGE MIX-UP

(Group activity; Break group into teams of 3-4. Have each team line up single file.) Materials needed: small balls and buckets to toss them in

Instructions:


- 1. Each team is given a message that they must try to deliver as correctly as possible. Some example messages could be:
 - "Sizzle, Hiss, Pop! Something's cooking!"
 - "Golden, brown, puffy, sweet, Kadooboo is a delicious treat!"
 - "Hurry home! It looks like rain!"
 - "Kadooboo! Can Kabir remember its name?"
- 2. The first team member is given the message.
- 3. Before passing on the message, each team member must retrieve a ball and then toss this ball into their team's bucket.
- 4. Once they successfully toss the ball into their bucket, each team member must whisper the message to the next team member.
- 5. Once the message reaches the last team member, and they toss a ball into the team's bucket, they'll announce the message they heard.
- 6. The team that gets their message closest to the original wins!
- 7. To make the game easier or more challenging:
 - Change up the wording or length of the messages
 - Remove or add in different "challenges" as the message is passed on.

Directions:

- 1. Cut out the tiles below, and lay them out in a grid.
- 2. Carefully look at the pictures for 30 seconds, paying close attention to the matching pairs.
- 3. Turn the tiles over so the pictures aren't showing.
- 4. Using your memory, try to select the matching pairs from the grid.
- 5. If you get a matching pair correct, it's your turn to try again. If you're incorrect, it's the next person's turn.
- 6. Whoever makes the most matching pairs wins!
